

Making a Propaganda Display

Task Researching World War I propaganda and creating a display

Purpose To highlight the role of propaganda in maintaining morale and support for the war at home

Instructions During World War I, both the Central Powers and the Allies generated propaganda designed to create a negative view of the enemy and support for their own cause. You will do research to find posters, flyers, and other graphics representing the enemy and enlisting support for the war effort at home.

During your research, collect the following information about each graphic:

- origin
- purpose
- intended audience
- method of distribution

Make copies of the graphics and insert them into a presentation. Each graphic should be accompanied by a caption explaining the information students have gathered about it.

You will have 3-4 graphics total.
